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List of demarcated areas for the presence of pine wood nematode as referred to in Article 5(1) of Commission Implementing Decision 2012/535/EU

Pursuant to Article 5(7) of Decision 2012/535/EU, the following areas are considered demarcated areas for the presence of pine wood nematode (PWN) as referred to in Article 5(1) of that Decision:

Demarcated areas subject to eradication measures pursuant to Article 6(1) of Decision 2012/535/EU

1. The area in a radius of 20 km around a PWN outbreak located in the municipality of **As Neves** (N 42° 08' 08.7"; W 8° 26' 38.3"; UTM coordinates HUSO 29 X 545951, Y 4664998), Pontevedra province, **Galicia** (Spain). Except for the outbreak site, the demarcated area consists entirely of a buffer zone.
2. The area in a radius of 20 km around a PWN outbreak located in the Barroco Toiriña forest area, in the municipality of **Valverde del Fresno** (UTM coordinates: HUSO 29 X 677474; Y 4457736), Cáceres province, **Extremadura** (Spain). Except for the outbreak site, the demarcated area consists entirely of a buffer zone.
3. The area in a radius of 20 km around a PWN outbreak located in the municipality of **Santi-Spíritus** (UTM coordinates: HUSO 30 X 211795; Y 4509866), Salamanca province, **Castilla y León** (Spain).

Demarcated areas subject to containment measures pursuant to Article 7(1) of Decision 2012/535/EU

1. The entire territory of **continental Portugal**, including a 20-km-wide buffer zone situated along the border with Spain.
2. The territory of the island of **Madeira** (Portugal), excluding the other islands in the Madeira archipelago (Porto Santo, Desertas, Selvagens). The buffer zone falls in the sea.
