

## **Information note concerning the corrected 3.1 version of TRACES**

1/ From now on pre-valid commercial transporters who have the necessary live animal long distance transport authorisation can be selected in the certificate. Previously, only valid commercial transporters were accepted.

Transporters with the status 'new' will not be accepted. Consequently, if the organisation does not yet exist in the TRACES database, it is preferable to create it beforehand through the 'organisation management' menu on the left, in order to insure that its status is at least pre-valid.

2/ Taking into account the adjustments put in place by the Commission, all TRACES users passwords will have to be replaced. Next time you connect, you will receive an error message indicating that your password has expired. You should then replace it by another consisting of 10 characters, with at least one capital letter, one number and one symbol. Moreover, you will be obliged to answer one security question.

3/ A temporary correction has been made at the departure date level. An interval of approximately 30 days has been set up between the declaration and departure dates, in order to be able to create a certificate with an earlier departure date.

4/ The printing problem of the container numbers and seals in the destination place and date has been resolved.

5/ The CVED certificate visualisation problem with the status 'draft' for the BIPs and the transitaires has also been resolved.

6/ Details of third country establishments approved by the prelisting procedure (LMS) are no longer modifiable via the 'organisations' menu.

7/ Certain improvements have been made to the RASFF note. The contact point at the Commission can from now on validate the RASFF notification without problem.
