

I. IMPROVEMENTS

I.1. Management of Third Country lists

I.1.1 Introduction of the lists publication date

In Third Country Establishments lists, the publication date now appears instead of date of printing.

I.1.2. Warning when generating a new list

On the Europa site, a warning icon now appears as soon as a Third Country Establishments list has been published. This warning will remain for 30 days after publication.

I.1.3. Classification of Third Country Establishments lists

A numerical classification has been introduced for Third Country Establishments lists whose approval number is exclusively made up of figures.

In that case, zero is not considered as a figure if it is placed before the approval number.

II. CORRECTIONS

II.1. INTRA Certificate

II.1.1. Additional guarantees as far as blue tongue is concerned

The requirements for exemptions from the exit ban applicable to live animals, BTA1, BTA2, BTA3, BTA4, BTA5, BTA6, BTA7 are now exclusive, i.e. that it is possible to select only one of the aforementioned requirements in the same certificate. If animals from a same consignment meet different conditions, as many certificates as there are conditions to identify the animals with a different status will have to be issued.

II.1.2. Correction of the problem affecting boxes BTA1 and BTA2

The issue affecting the checkboxes in sentences BTA1 and BTA2 and that was generating an unexpected error GEN001 when validating the certificate has been corrected.

II.2. IMPORT Certificate

II.2.1. Place of loading

The "place of loading" (box I.13) in the "Transport" tab of the IMPORT certificate can now be selected for products, by-products and semen. As a reminder, this box was only accessible in certificates issued for animals. The information linked to the consignor (box I.1) is automatically copied in box I.13 "place of loading", with the possibility for modifications.

III. CERTIFICATION

III.1 IMPORT

III.1.1. By-products (R 829/2007)

Certificates relating to by-products (R 1774/2002) have been partially replaced by certificates from Regulation 829/2007 of 28 June 2007. This version only counts the modified certificates from chapters 1, 3A, 3B, 3C, 3D, 3E, 5A, 5B, 5C and 13 of Annex X.

A new certificate on processed manure and processed manure products (R 829/2007 chapter 17) has been introduced. The related HS code is 3101.

Requirements on the prevention, control and eradication of certain transmissible spongiform encephalopathies of Regulation 722/2007 Chapter D have been integrated in certificates from chapters 1, 3A, 3B, 3C, 3D, 3E, 3F, 4B, 10A, 11, 12 and 14B.

Certificates from chapters 2A, 2B, 2C, 3F, 4A, 4B, 4C, 6A, 6B, 7A, 7B, 8, 9, 10A, 10B, 11, 12, 14A, 14B and 15, mainly including modifications relating to the notes, will be modified in a future version.

III.1.2 Fishery products from the United States (2006/199/EC)

The certificate on fishery products from the United States has been introduced in accordance with Decision 2006/199 by integrating the animal health conditions of Regulation 1664/2006.
