II. HEALTH INFORMATION

Part II Zoosanitary information

General requirements

- II.1. Sweden is free from African Swine Fever (ASF), Classical Swine Fever (CSF), Foot- and Mouth Disease (FMD), enzootic encephalitis (Japanese encephalitis), haemorrhagic septicemia, melioidosis, Nipah virus infection, porcine brucellosis, porcine enterovirus encephalomyelitis, rabies, rinderpest, swine vesicular disease (SVD), transmissible gastroenteritis (TGE), vesicular exanthema of swine and vesicular stomatitis.
II.2. African Swine Fever (ASF), Classical Swine Fever (CSF), Foot- and Mouth Disease (FMD), enzootic encephalitis (Japanese encephalitis), haemorrhagic septicemia, melioidosis, Nipah virus infection, porcine brucellosis, porcine enterovirus encephalomyelitis, rabies, rinderpest, swine vesicular disease (SVD), transmissible gastroenteritis (TGE), vesicular exanthema of swine and vesicular stomatitis are designated as notifiable diseases in Sweden.
II.3. Vaccination against Classical Swine Fever (CSF), Foot- and Mouth Disease (FMD) and rinderpest as well as importation of cloven-hoofed animals that have been vaccinated against any of these diseases are completely prohibited in Sweden.

Requirements for the premises of origin

- II.4. In the premises of origin there has been no outbreak of anthrax, atrophic rhinitis, Aujeszky's disease (AD), blackleg, leptospirosis, porcine epidemic diarrhea, porcine reproductive and respiratory syndrome (PRRS), salmonellosis, swine dysentery, swine erysipelas, tularemia and toxoplasmosis for at least 12 months before the commencement of the pre-export quarantine.
II.5. The premises of origin are located only in Sweden or third free countries.
II.6. Feeding of swill is prohibited in Sweden.
II.7. No swine have been introduced to the premises of origin where the exported swine are kept for at least 40 days prior to the pre-export quarantine.

Requirements for the exported swine

- II.8. The exported swine have not been vaccinated against porcine brucellosis and Aujeszky's disease (AD).
II.9. The exported swine have been in contact only with swine born and raised in Sweden or the third free countries.
II.10. The exported swine have been kept isolated and have been in no contact with animals other than the exported swine for at least 30 days prior to the shipment to Japan in the pre-export quarantine facilities.

Requirements for the examinations

II.11. The exported swine shall be subjected to the following examinations with negative results (or medication for leptospirosis) by the animal health authorities of Sweden during the pre-export quarantine period. In the event that any of the exported swine is tested positive for Classical Swine Fever (CSF) and Porcine Reproductive and Respiratory Syndrome (PRRS) during the pre-export quarantine period they shall not be eligible for export to Japan.

II.12. The exported swine showed no sign of any infectious disease through careful clinical inspection conducted by the official veterinarian of animal health authorities of Sweden during the pre-export quarantine period.

Requirements for transportation

II.13. All containers, vehicles, equipments and loading place to be used for the transportation of the exported swine shall be cleaned in advance of loading and be thoroughly disinfected with disinfectant approved by the animal health authorities of Sweden under the supervision of the said authorities.

II.14. The exported swine have been kept isolated from any other cloven-hoofed animals and horses during the transportation period in Sweden. No cloven-hoofed animals and horses are permitted to be mixloaded with the exported swine at the time of shipment to Japan.

II.15. Feed and litter to be used during the transportation period of the exported swine to Japan are provided from the same source used for the pre-export quarantine.

II.16. No additional feed and litter is allowed to be provided at any port during transportation of the exported swine to Japan.

II.17. The exported swine shall be transported to Japan directly or only via third free countries. If the exported swine are not sent directly to Japan, they shall be transported and treated in a secure way for animal health purpose in the transit countries.
